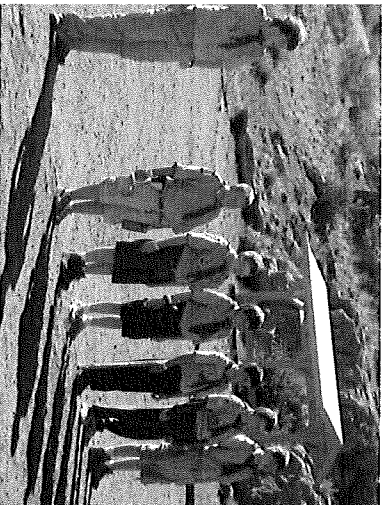


A PLACE FOR SCOUTS TO GROW AND EXCEL!

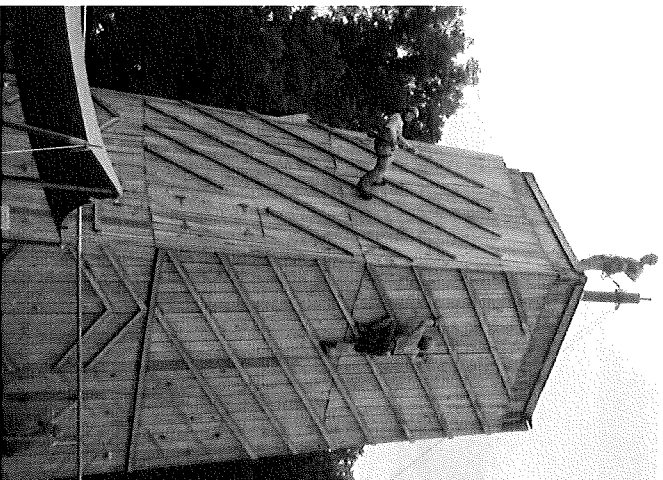

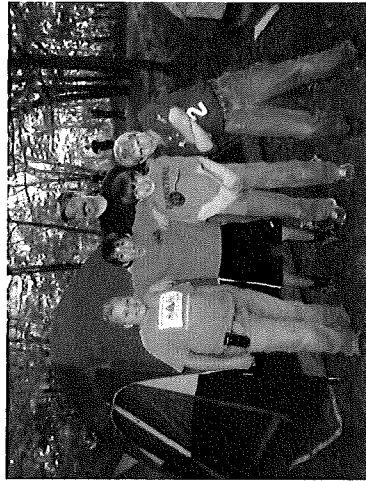

About Our Troop

Troop 706 has over 40 years of experience in providing young men with positive scouting experiences this troop believes that every scouting activity moves young men towards 3 basic aims: 1) character development, 2) citizenship training and 3) mental and physical fitness. A large percentage of Troop 706's scouts have advanced to the rank of EAGLE.

Weekend Camping

Every month during the school year Troop 706 organizes one or more weekend outings. Normally these are overnight camping trips

Sometimes these experiences involve bicycling, backpacking, hiking, canoeing, and snow skiing. Areas we commonly camp include Finger Lakes State Park, Three Creeks State Park, Mark Twain National Forest, Rock Bridge State Park. We generally camp within a 30-mile radius of Columbia in scout-designated campgrounds.

Service Projects

Troop 706 has been a regular participant in the annual Food Drive to support the Central Missouri Food Bank, and has adopted a section of the MKT Trail. In addition, the Eagle projects in the troop typically focus on community improvement projects where a number of troop members are asked to participate.

Summer Events

Troop 706 has an active scouting program during the summer. Each summer Troop 706 attends a one-week summer scout camp. At camp, scouts participate in a variety of scout activities and merit badge classes including swimming, fishing, canoeing, rowing, first aid, lifesaving, camping, horseback riding, environmental science, archery, and rifle shooting.

Philmont

Arguably one of the most beautiful areas in the country dedicated to scouting activities, Philmont is located in the mountains near Cimarron, New Mexico. The older scouts of Troop 706 have completed Philmont Treks which include hiking and backpacking for 60-100 miles in 11 days, panning for gold, horseback riding, rock climbing, rappelling, and enjoying the great New Mexico Rocky Mountains with old and new friends. In route to Philmont, older scouts have gone white water rafting on the Arkansas River and through the Royal Gorge of Colorado.

High Adventure

Troop 706 schedules a high adventure trip each summer. Scouts and adult leaders have canoed, portaged, and camped 54 miles along the Current River National Scenic Riverway. Fishing, hiking, and swimming occupied much of their time.
